The Battle of Belleau Wood (1–26 June 1918) occurred during the German Spring Offensive in World War I, near the Marne River in France. The battle was fought between the U.S. 2nd (under the command of Major General Omar Bundy) and 3rd Divisions along with French and British forces against an assortment of German units including elements from the 237th, 10th, 197th, 87th, and 28th Divisions.

But the great battles of WW I were also much more costly than any single battle in WW II, often in the hundreds of thousands. For instance, on 1 July 1916, the first day of the Battle of the Somme, the British Army alone had over 58,000 casualties, 20,000 of which were killed that day (there were over 20,000 casualties in the first hour alone) mainly caused by German machine guns.
