No more than two jamboree patches may be worn on the shirt—one current national jamboree patch above the right pocket and one current world jamboree patch on the right pocket. If the wearer has an interpreter strip above the pocket, merely move the jamboree emblem upward sufficiently to accommodate it.

Boy Scouts of America strip is centered above the pocket. Order of the Arrow lodge insignia is worn on the pocket flap. Current national Scout jamboree insignia is centered above the BSA strip and any other items above the pocket. Optional insignia, if worn, is placed in the following order, from the BSA strip upward: interpreter strip, Venture or

The trained strip is worn just below the badge of office. On the official uniform shirt, the veteran unit bar (25, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, or 80 years) is positioned above and touching the troop numeral; below and touching the council emblem. Den chief cord is worn over the left shoulder, under epaulet.

Uniform Guides | Badge Magic

The BSA Insignia Guide discusses all the uniforming, patch placement, and other insignia use. Merit badge placement on the sash is up to the scout. The badges can be displayed in rows of two or three, starting three inches down from the top of the sash. There is no required ordering of badges.

Boy Scout Uniform

Boy Scout youth advancement patches may be worn on the Venturing uniform, but they cannot wear both the Boy Scout rank patch and a Venturing Awards patch at the same time. Venturers may also wear the Arrow of Light and Eagle knots if earned. A female Venturer or adult advisor may wear the Girl Scout Gold Award if earned in Girl Scouting.

Required Insignia Required insignia include council shoulder patches, unit numbers, patrol emblems, and veteran bar emblems. When a Scout's den or troop has a set of shared badges, it provides a sense of community and fellowship that Scouting is determined to build and help flourish.

A Visual Guide for Badges, Pins, Insignia, Awards, and More Select your grade level to learn where to place insignia on your Girl Scout uniform. Girl Scouts from each grade level have one official uniform item (a sash, vest, or tunic) to display badges, pins, insignia, and awards.

Where to Place Insignia - Girl Scouts

Left Sleeve Cub Scout Patch Placement. Let's start with the left sleeve. Your Council shoulder emblem goes at the very top along the shoulder seam. It is shown as position 1 on the diagram above. Just below the Council shoulder emblem at position 2a is where the small Veteran Unit Emblem is worn if you use it.

The World Crest is worn by all members of Scouting to symbolize their membership in the World Scouting movement. It is worn above the left pocket. 1. Scout's current badge of rank is worn on his left pocket. The ranks are (in order of advancement) Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, Life and Eagle.

T618 Uniform Patch Placement Guide

U.S. flag emblem,cloth, red, white, and blue, No. 103; all members, right sleeve, position 1. New uniforms have this emblem already sewn in the correct position. The U.S. Flag Code allows the BSA to continue to wear the flag in the traditional orientation of the field of stars to the left.

Merit badges ONLY are worn on the FRONT of the sash. On the back of the sash, additional merit badges may be sewn as well as temporary insignia may be sewn. "Temporary insignia" is defined by the BSA as special insignia for participating in unit, District, Council or national events or programs.
