People in this age group seem to have a different set of needs and responses to treatment than children, teens, and older adults with mental illness.

The developmental life stage from late adolescence to early adulthood (16-25) is referred to as emerging adulthood (EA). This stage is also when early symptoms of diagnosable mental health problems and illnesses most often emerge. It is also when EAs face the most barriers in accessing service and supports.
