A smart PMO will ensure that they have processes in place to track key metrics in order to demonstrate the value that is being added by the PMO through the improvement of project delivery. Metrics to Measure the Success of a PMO

Projects are made from many parts, more than the three, albeit major ones, that make up the Triple Constraint.
